

ELIGIBLE TRAINING PROVIDERS NOTICE

The Middle Georgia Consortium is accepting applications for Training organizations to become Eligible Training Providers for local Workforce areas in Georgia under the Federal Workforce Development Act (WIOA). This notice does not apply to training providers and programs that are automatically eligible or exempt under WIOA. The Baldwin County Government is the fiscal agent and the Middle Georgia Consortium is the administrative entity for the ten-county area, which includes Baldwin, Crawford, Houston, Jones, Monroe, Peach, Pulaski, Putnam, Twiggs and Wilkinson.

Applications should include the program(s) of study requested for approval. Approved programs are eligible to receive referrals for adults, dislocated workers, and youth who may then be enrolled in the training and have their expenses reimbursed with WIOA funds by the Consortium or other local WIOA workforce development agencies. Expenses reimbursed may include tuition, fees, books and supplies. Training included in the application must exist at the time of application and courses must be currently available. Other requirements may also apply.

Provider applications must be approved by the Middle Georgia Workforce Development Board (WDB) and Executive Committee, and will then be forwarded to the Georgia Department of Economic Development Workforce Division (GDEcD) for review. Upon completion of the GDEcD review, the training provider and its approved program(s) will be included on the State's Eligible Provider List and published throughout statewide one-stop centers.
